

Omaha Trails Update

7 July 2021

TRAIL CLOSED SUMMARY – SEE SPECIFIC TRAIL FOR ADDITIONAL DETAILS:

Big Papio Trail – Section remains closed from Cancer Survivors Park (S. 105th & Pacific Streets) to just north of the West Dodge Frontage Road until further notice. There is no suggested detour for this trail closure.

Boulevard Trail (a.k.a. Happy Hollow Trail) - A section of the trail from just north of Dodge Street north to Chicago Street remains closed for repair work. Trail will remain closed through mid-July 2021. There is a suggested detour for this trail closure. Trail users can use the sidewalk on the eastern side of Happy Hollow Boulevard.

Flanagan Lake Trail – On Tuesday, July 6, 2021 a section of the Flanagan Lake Trail on the western and southern portions of the lake will be closed for construction work by Pier 15-SID #585. Trail will be closed through Friday, July 9, 2021. There is no suggested detour for this trail closure.

Heartland of America Park Trails – All trails remain closed in the park. Trails will remain closed through the Spring of 2023. There is no suggested detour for this trail closure.

Keystone Trail – On Monday, July 12, 2021 a section of the Keystone Trail from Blondo Street to Western Avenue (Hillside Little League Park) will be closed for the replacement of a storm drainage pipe that runs underneath the trail. Work is being done by the Papio-Missouri River Natural Resources District. Trail will be closed through Tuesday, July 27, 2021. There is a suggested detour for this trail closure. Trail users can use Blondo Street to 85th Street to Western Avenue.

Riverfront Trail - Trail remains closed from Heartland of America Park to the Martin Luther King Jr. Pedestrian Bridge. Trail will remain closed through the Spring of 2023. There is no suggested detour for this trail closure.

Skyline Trail - On Wednesday, July 7, 2021 a section of the Skyline Trail from the N. Skyline Drive/Honeysuckle Drive intersection to the Blondo Street/N. 209th Street intersection was closed due to a section of the trail being washed out. The Omaha Parks & Recreation Department will be making the repairs. There is a suggested detour for this trail closure. Trail users can use Honeysuckle Drive to N. 209th Street to Parker Street to N. Main Street.

144th STREET TRAIL

- Trail is currently open with no closures.

BARRINGTON PARK CONNECTOR TRAIL

- Trail is currently open with no closures.

BIG PAPIO TRAIL

- Trail remains closed from Cancer Survivors Park (s. 105th & Pacific Streets) to just north of the West Dodge Frontage Road as a result of the March flooding. Trail is undermined in places, concrete panels have been dislodged and the rail is covered with silt. No timetable at this time as to when this section will reopen. There is no suggested detour for this trail closure.

BLONDO STREET TRAIL (Big Papio Trail to N. 153rd Avenue)

- Trail is currently open with no closures.

BOB KERREY PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE

- Bob Kerrey Pedestrian Bridge is currently open.

BOULEVARD TRAIL (a.k.a. the HAPPY HOLLOW TRAIL)

- A section of the trail from just north of Dodge Street north to Chicago Street is closed for repair work. Trail will remain closed through mid-July 2021. There is a suggested detour for this trail closure. Trail users can use the sidewalk on the eastern side of Happy Hollow Boulevard.

BROOKHAVEN PARK TRAIL

- Trail is currently open with no closures.

FIELD CLUB TRAIL

- Trail is currently open with no closures.

FLANAGAN LAKE & RECREATION AREA

- On Tuesday, July 6, 2021 a section of the Flanagan Lake Trail on the western and southern portions of the lake will be closed for construction work by Pier 15-SID #585. Trail will be closed through Friday, July 9, 2021. There is no suggested detour for this trail closure.

HEARTLAND OF AMERICA PARK TRAILS

- All trails remain closed in the park. Trails will remain closed through the Spring of 2023. There is no suggested detour for this trail closure.

HIKING TRAILS AT HUMMEL PARK

- All trails are currently open with no closures.

KEYSTONE TRAIL

- On Monday, July 12, 2021 a section of the Keystone Trail from Blondo Street to Western Avenue (Hillside Little League Park) will be closed for the replacement of a storm drainage pipe that runs underneath the trail. Work is being done by the Papio-Missouri River Natural Resources District.

Trail will be closed through Tuesday, July 27, 2021. There is a suggested detour for this trail closure. Trail users can use Blondo Street to 85th Street to Western Avenue.

LAMP PARK TRAIL

- Trail is currently open with no closures.

MOUNTAIN BIKE/HIKING TRAILS AT TRANQUILITY PARK

- All trails are currently open with no closures.

RIVERFRONT TRAIL NORTH (Heartland of America Park to Washington County Line)

- Trail remains closed from Heartland of America Park to the Martin Luther King Jr. Pedestrian Bridge. Trail will remain closed through the Spring of 2023. There is no suggested detour for this trail closure.

RIVERFRONT TRAIL SOUTH (Heartland of America Park to Veterans Memorial Bridge)

- Trail is currently open with no closures.

SKYLINE TRAIL (West Dodge Road to North Main Street and Park Road – Elkhorn)

- Trail is currently open with no closures.

SOUTH OMAHA TRAIL

- On Wednesday, July 7, 2021 a section of the Skyline Trail from the N. Skyline Drive/Honeysuckle Drive intersection to the Blondo Street/N. 209th Street intersection was closed due to a section of the trail being washed out. The Omaha Parks & Recreation Department will be making the repairs. There is a suggested detour for this trail closure. Trail users can use Honeysuckle Drive to N. 209th Street to Parker Street to N. Main Street.

STANDING BEAR LAKE & RECREATION AREA TRAIL

- Trail is currently open with no closures.

TURNER BOULEVARD TRAIL

- Trail is currently open with no closures.

WEST PAPIO TRAIL

- Trail is currently open from Huntington Park south to Millard Avenue and from "Q." Street & Harry Andersen Avenue south to Giles Road.

ZORINSKY LAKE & RECREATION AREA TRAIL

- Trail is currently open with no closures.
